

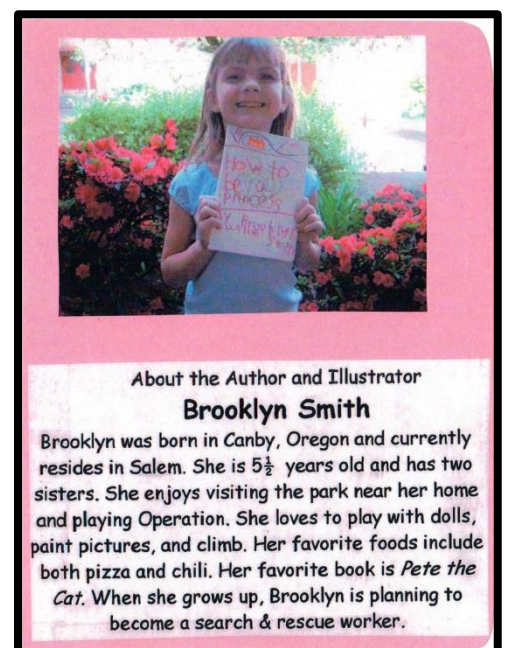
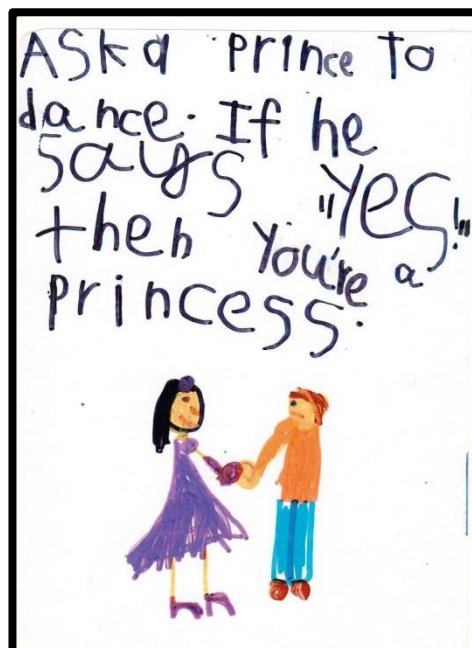
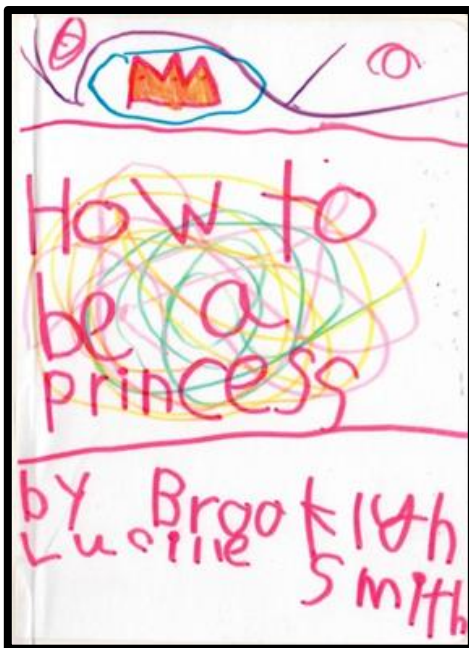
Allow Your Writing Framework to Nurture Creativity
