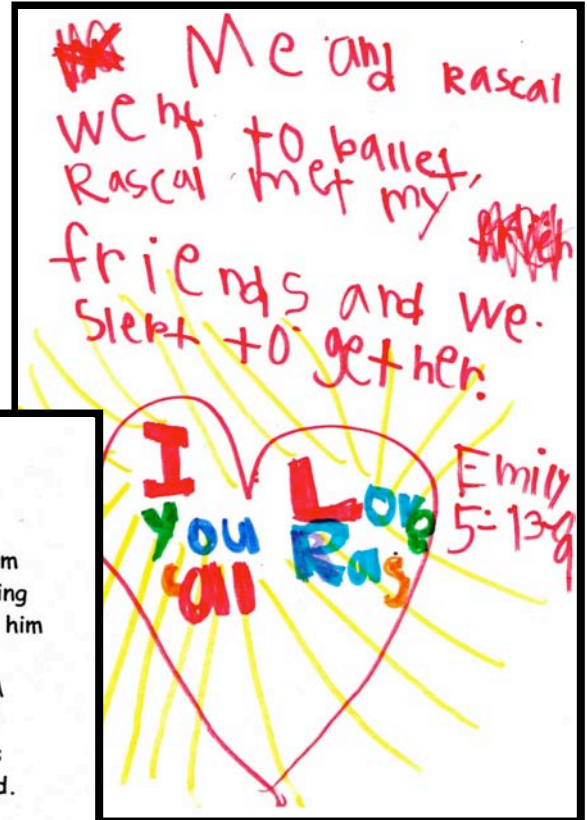


# Rascal and His Journal Comes Home for a Visit: Read About His Adventures

Thank you for welcoming Rascal into your home.

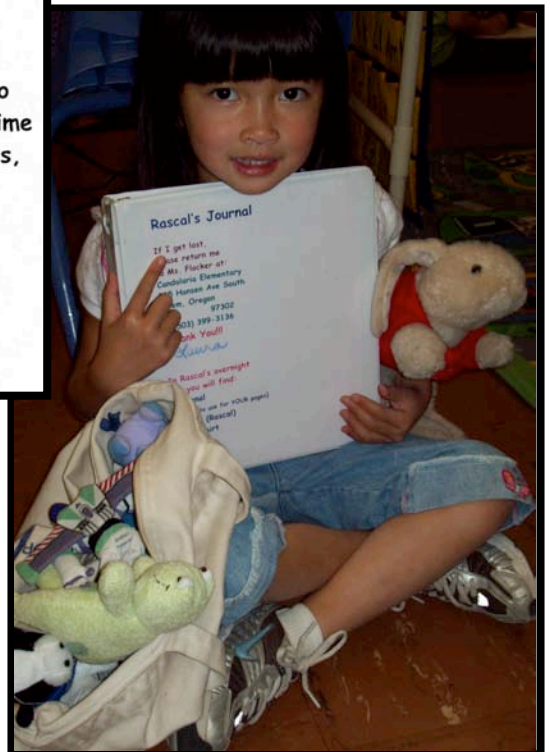
